About Jeevodaya

Jeevodaya is a non-profit organisation begun in 1999, with the passion of helping children, living alone in and around Railway stations, runaway and missing children, by providing food, shelter and education. In order to make Itarsi a child-friendly station, Sr.Clara,Sisters of St. Joseph of Chambéry, started Jeevodaya Sociey. Over the past 21 years, Jeevodaya has given to more than 30,000 children, the necessary support of a secure and dignified life, as also reuniting them with their biological families, providing rehabilitation and vocational formation.

In the course of the journey, Jeevodaya learned that if these children were not helped on time, they would end up begging, be used for child labour, anti-social activities and trafficked for flesh trade. Moreover, these innocent children would lose the opportunity of enjoying their childhood and would be denied developmental opportunities. Hence, Jeevodaya decided to work in ITARSI itself, establishing a temporary shelter home for children in need of care, security and protection in collaboration with Western Central Railway Women's Welfare Organisation. In addition, Jeevodaya established long-term shelters for girls and boys with the support of Donors and Religious Congregations. Jeevodaya ensures that these children are provided with education, vocational training, care and affection till the age of 18 and thereafter, supported with ongoing vocational training and higher education.

In 2020, Jeevodaya celebrates the completion of 21years of a journey from the platforms of Itarsi Railway Station to providing quality residential facilities for rescued children through Child Care Institutions and various other related programmes for the holistic rehabilitation of these children.

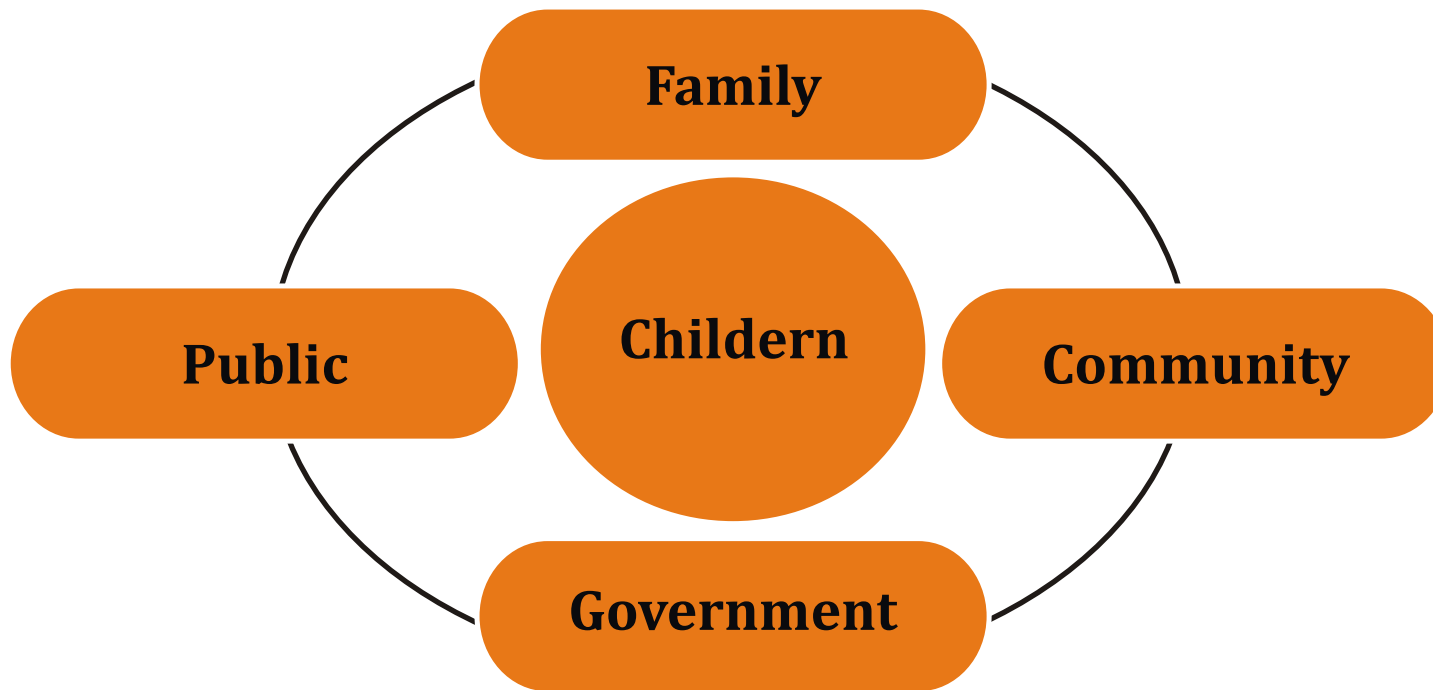

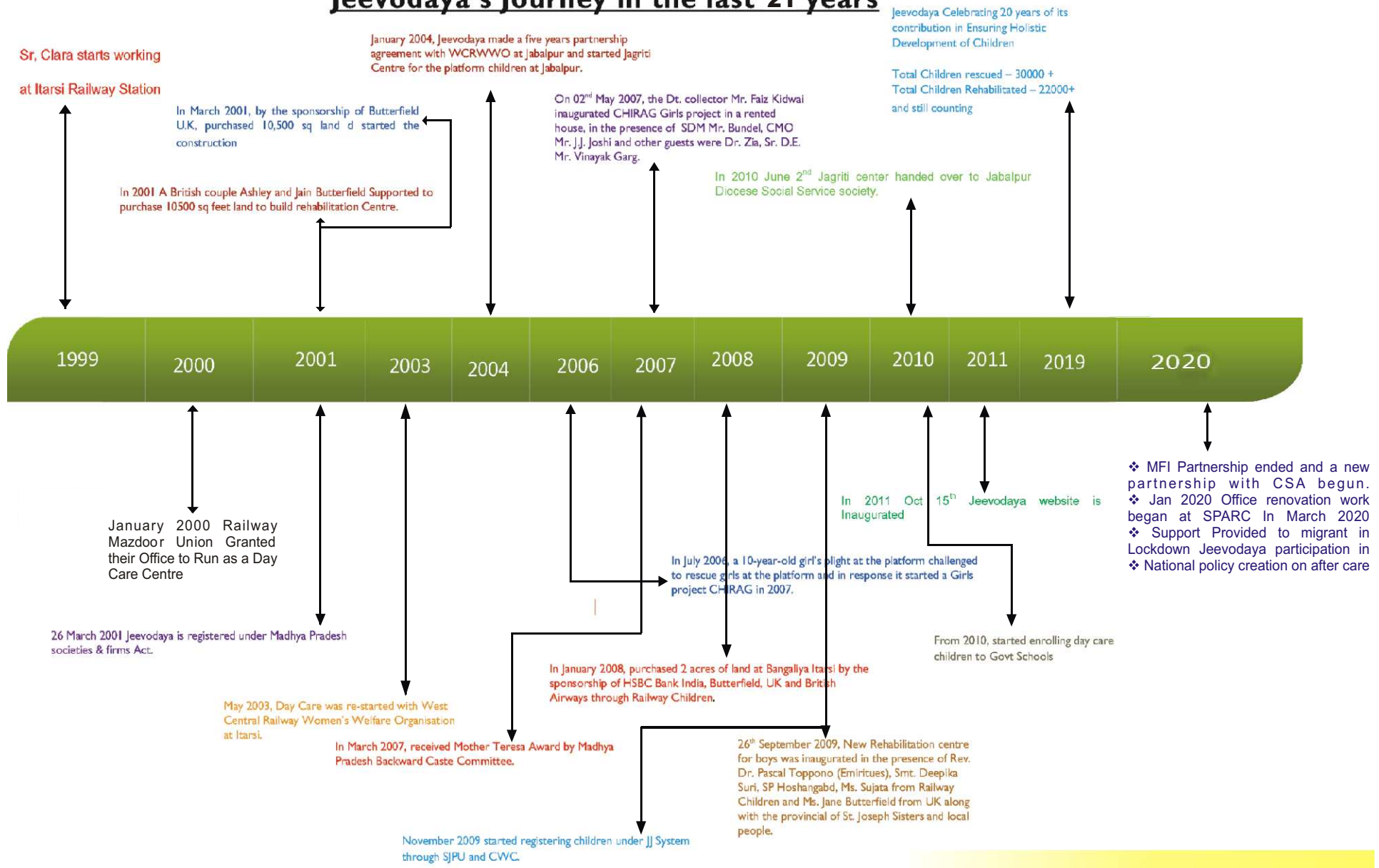
Our Approach

Jeevodaya's Journey in the last 21 years



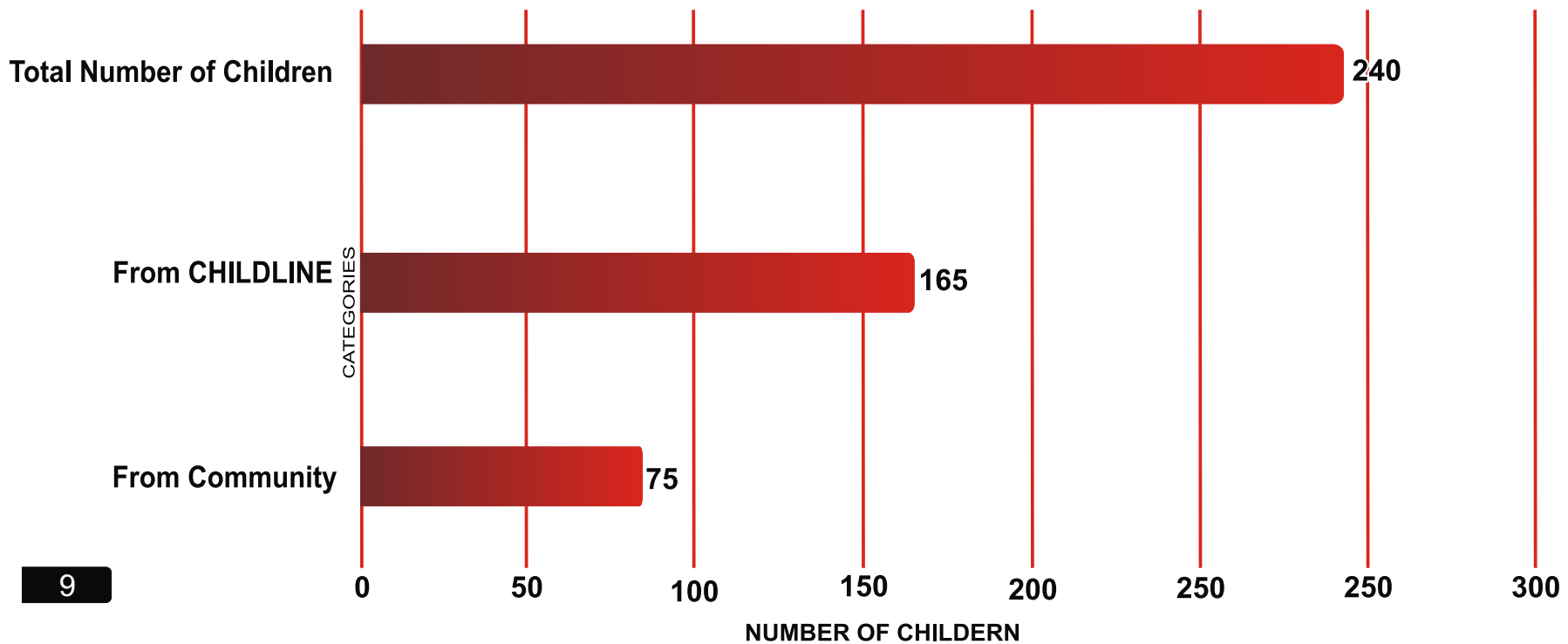
Programs at a Glance

SAMYOG-Drop-in Centre and Community Outreach Program

Samyog the day care and community outreach service started at 1999 for the children who were living in the station premises in the in Mazdoor Union Office. Later the Railway gave a building in Porter Chawl near Maal Gudam near Railway Station and the Drop In Centre was re started in new building in 2003.

Today the Drop In Centre functions as a community centre and a shelter for the children who needs care and protection. Various meetings and trainings for stakeholders and community children are organised in DIC time to time.

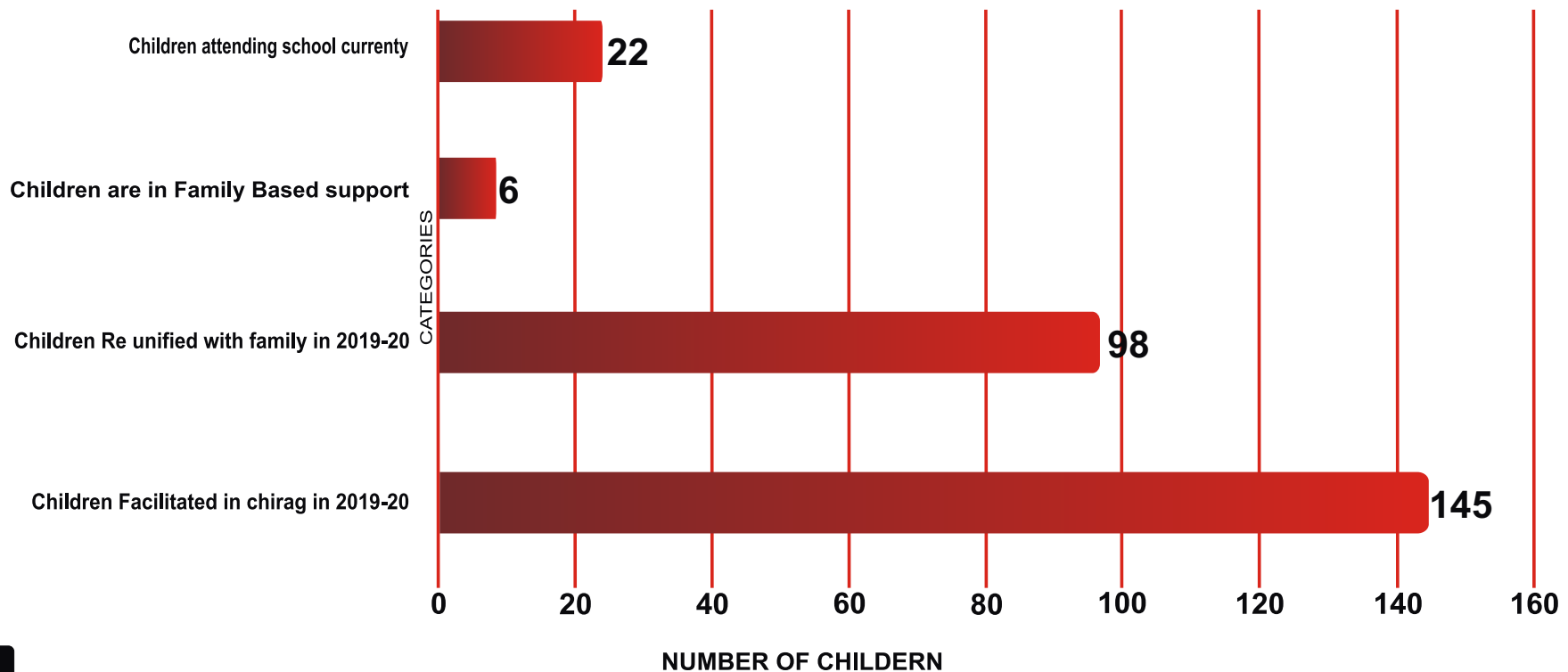
Children facilitated at Drop In Centre (April 2019 March 2020)



Chirag-the home for girls is founded in 2006 for the girls who need care and protection. In the period of **April 2019 to March 2020**, total 145 children were supported and facilitated in Chirag. In Chirag, where children are provided, shelter, food, medical support and counselling. For all children Individual Care Plans are made and periodically updated. Once the child is placed for a long period of time, she is enrolled in a school.

Computer education and extra tuition supports are provided to every child with a prepared syllabus. Children who are good in extracurricular activities are given special training such as in Painting, Art & crafts, Drawing etc. additional training at weekends is also given to children on cloth cutting and stitching.

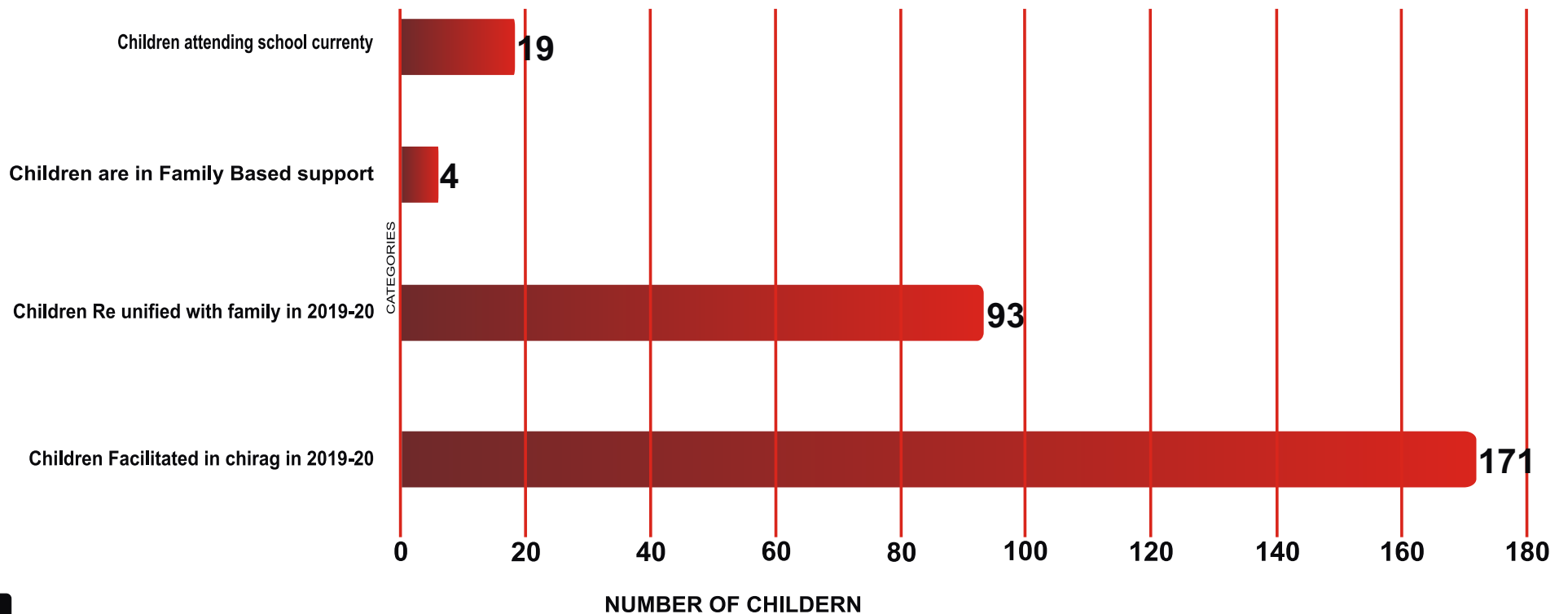
CHIRAG at a Glance (April 2019-March 2020)



Sparc a residential facility for rescued boys, with a capacity of 35 children was founded in 2001. In 2019-20, 171 children from various sources were facilitated in Sparc. 93 children were restored /reunited with families in this period. Children who have been here for a longer period of time with orders from CWC, were enrolled in schools and provided further support for education.

Children good in sports and extracurricular activities were given special training and opportunities for participating in competitions. We have tied up with Madhya Pradesh Sports Academy for admissions of suitable children.

SPARC at a Glance (April 2019-March 2020)

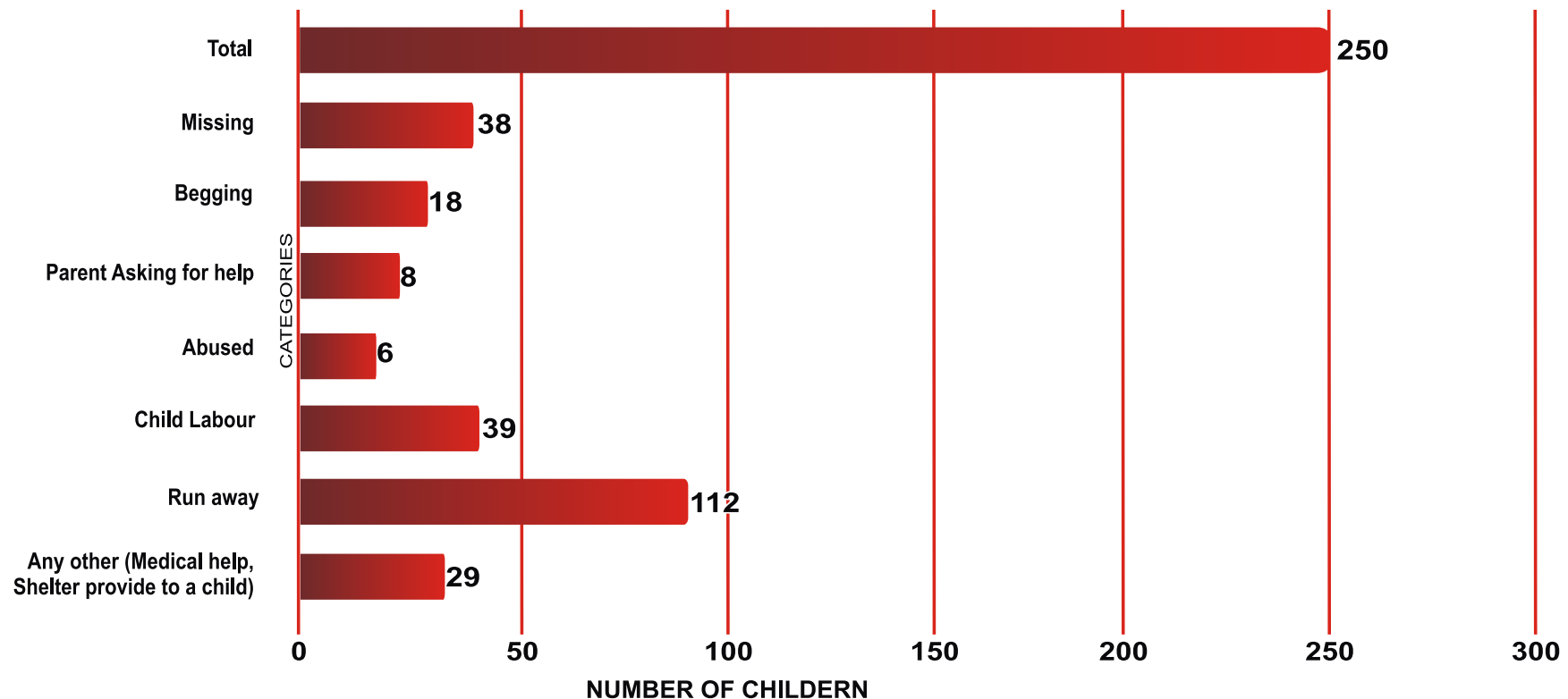


Since 2018 Jeevodaya has been running the Child Help Desk (CHD) based on the SOP of Railways and with CHILDLINE India Foundation at Itarsi railway Junction. The objective of the project is to rescue children 24X7 from the Railway station, as per Railway SOP guidelines, and reintegrate them with society, collecting information which is produced before Child welfare committee, according to Juvenile Justice Act 2015.

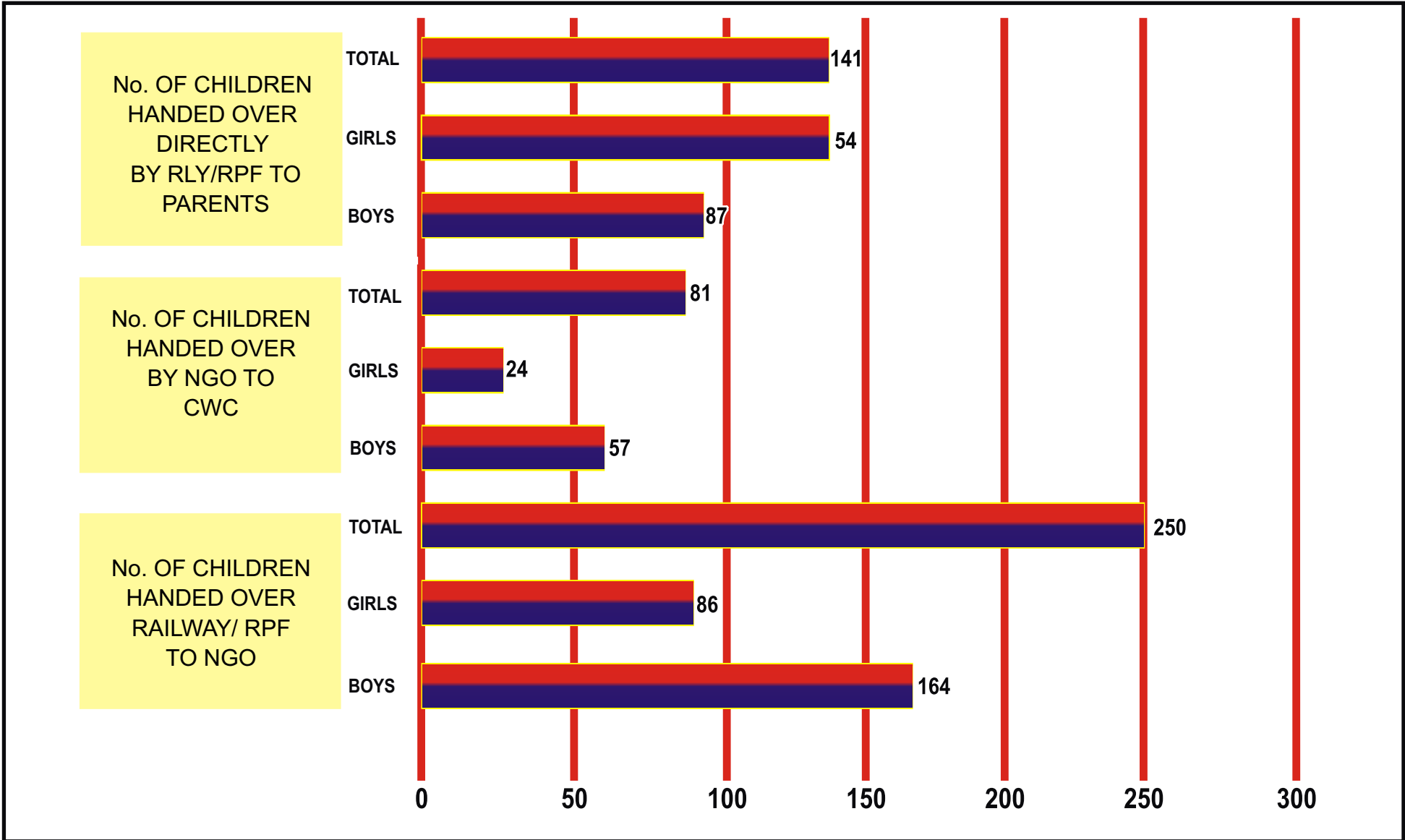
Between April 2019 and March 2020, 250 children were rescued at the Jeevodaya Railway CHILDLINE (JRCL) team. Most of these children are reunited with the family. Children's needs at the Institutional care were given support. Once rescued and rehabilitated, the JRCL team gives follow up for 3 months to 2 years based on the need of the particular child/case.

Also the JRCL team has a major role in sensitising and educating stakeholders, such as GRP, RPF, Railway Employees etc on Child Protection and major role of stakeholders etc . In this reporting year we have sensitized 115 stakeholders through various programmes and events.

Major Achievements & Activities 2019-20

Children Helped through Outreach Service:

In 2019-20, 250 children (164 boys + 86 girls) from Itarsi Railway Junction of West Central Railway Zone of Indian Railways helped, among whom 235 children were reunited with their families. Follow ups for the rehabilitated children are carried out by JRCL team members on regular intervals to ensure the wellbeing of these children.

Publication and release of Jeevodaya Annual report

2018-19 was done on 16 Oct. 2019, by Hon. Shri Girish Sharma IAS (Principal Advisor AIVGPA) on the occasion of Jeevodaya Annual Day celebrations, in the presence of a distinguished gathering.

CHILDLINE se Dosti campaign:

Jeevodaya Railway CHILDLINE celebrated CHILDLINE se Dosti campaign on 14 Nov. 2019 Universal Child Rights Day- at CHIRAG and Itarsi Railway Station. The children from Jeevodaya Children's Home together with Staff were part of the campaign. The Team presented Awareness on Child Rights to Govt. Stakeholders such as Railway Station Suptd., Deputy Station Suptd, Inspector RPF, Inspector GRP, Army Officials, Itarsi local Police Station and non-Govt Stakeholders like coolies, vendors, shopkeepers, youth and railway passengers from Itarsi Rly. Station these were all part of the campaign. This was one of the major sensitization programmes held with support of children, staff and stakeholders.

Sustainability Plan for 2020 2025

Jeevodaya has prepared a detailed plan for Organisation Sustainability with Mumbai-based experts. The plan includes year-wise activities and roles of each Department of the Organisation to attain and develop self-sustainability by 2025.

CHILDLINE Se Dosti Campaign 2019



Miracle Partnership replaced with CSA.

Jeevodaya ended partnership with Miracle Foundation India in December 2019 and now collaborate with Catylist for Social Action (CSA) to ensure our children's wellbeing and support. CSA will be working closely with Jeevodaya for children's education, health, mental health, computer education etc in a professional and systematic manner.

Office renovation In Sparc started in January 2020

We began renovation of the office in Sparc Boys' Home in January 2020, since the major section of the Main Office is shifting to Sparc. As per the plan, the Accounts and Programme Manager's Office is shifting to Sparc while the office of the Sparc children's home and other Home activity premises are shifting to the 1st Floor. The work was expected to be completed by the end of July 2020, but now delayed due to the pandemic.

Participation at National policy development on After Care

In Feb.2020, Sr.Clara attended a 3-day workshop in Lucknow on After-Care Policy conducted by the Dept of WCD and UNICEF. The meeting was helpful. Sr.Clara shared her experiences and views in the preparation of the Policy. The invitation was offered to Sr.Clara in respect of her long 21 years experience in working with children in need of care & Protection.

Monitored visits by Govt. officials

Govt. system have now taken ownership of the Protection of Children as per the directions of the Supreme Court of India and Govt. Ministries both in Central & State Govts. As a result, Govt Officials visit/monitor Jeevodaya homes regularly, esp ICPS officials, CWC, District Judges, Tribal Welfare Officer, District & State Level Women & Child Dept. Officials.

CHILD Help Group Meetings:

As per the Railway SOP, CHILD Help Group was formed at the Itarsi Railway Junction under the ægis of Station Suptd.Inspector RPF, SSO, GRP, CTI and Jeevodaya are part of this group. From April 2019 to March 2020, 3 CHG meetings were organized at which Jeevodaya presented many advocacy issues for discussion.

Major Achievements & Activities 2019-20

Child rights and Child Protection Training in Schools:

Jeevodaya has Sensitized **550 children (326 Girls and 224 Boys)** on the Safety & Protection through Good touch and Bad touch Sessions in various schools of Itarsi. Also, we provide psychosocial support to children who are in need and are identified through these sessions.

20th Annual day celebration of Jeevodaya

On 16th November, 2019 Jeevodaya celebrated its 20th Annual day with Children, older children/youth, Government stakeholders, guests, well-wishers and staff. The theme was “We have a Dream.” Children presented cultural activities based on the theme and how Jeevodaya is instrumental in bringing colour into their lives. Mr. Sanjay Bhatnagar (DGM-PowerGrid, Itarsi) was the chief guest **and Mr. Girish Sharma IAS** (Principal Advisor AIVGPA-MP) the guest of honour.

COVID-19 Relief Activities

During COVID-19 Pandemic we supported, in the month of March 2020, 70 Migrant Families, living at Itarsi Railway Station premises, by providing milk, biscuit, provisions & medicine.



Case Study -1

Child Guddu (name changed), a resident of Jabalpur, is an 8 year old boy. His parents work as labourers. He has a younger sister. Parents had gone to work. Guddu went, with a friend, to the park, near his house, where both boys played. Someone arrived and told them to accompany him for a walk but they were taken to Madan Mahal station and put in the train towards Mumbai. When the boys came to Itarsi station, they jumped off. A RPF staff asked the children how they had reached there. Later, RPF staff brought the children to Child Help Desk 1098 and handed them over to Jeevodaya Railway CHILDLINE team. Counseling was done for both the children. During the conversation, the JRCL staff contacted the family of the children who were presented to the Child Welfare Committee, Hoshangabad. In view of the care and safety of the children we provide shelter to them, Next day, the family came and as per the order of the child welfare committee the children were handed over to the family, Parents were very Happy to receive their children safely. Currently the children are with the family.

Case Study -2

Sona (name changed) from Nagpur, Maharashtra, was from a poor family. Her parents used to go to work. She had two more siblings, all younger. Her family was in a poor financial condition. Sona is a student of class 11 and wants to study further. She said that she got disturbed repeatedly about anything from her mother's side, Parents did not want to teach her further, but she loved to study. But as parents were not financially fit, she left home and went to Nagpur alone and through train she reached Itarsi. She saw the Child Help Desk 1098 at Itarsi railway station and came to CHD for help, where Sona shared her concerns and problems. It is reported by the staff of Jeevodaya Railway CHILDLINE, then the child was counselled by the Counsellor and presented before the Child Welfare Committee, Hoshangabad and the family contacted. The girl presented her problems before the Child Welfare Committee. The family came to Itarsi with the Police and important documents. CWC ordered the girl to be taken over by CCI of Nagpur district. Sona was handed over to Maharashtra Police. Presently the child is in CCI, continuing her studies.

In shelter home at five, Arjun shoots his way to national skeet team at 18

Bhopal: At the age of five, he lost his family and took refuge in a shelter home. Now, aged 18, he has been selected for the Indian shoot team, which is to participate in the world championship and world cup later this year. Arjun Thakur, the 18-year-old shooter of MP Shooting Academy, is all excited to represent the tricolor for the first time in his life. Despite being a junior, he will represent the country in the senior and junior world meets. The world championship will be in Lenox in Italy while the World Cup is scheduled to be held in Schieda, Germany. Being selected in the India team is nothing short of a fairy tale for Arjun. He lost his family when he was just five years old. "I do not share my story with people. But, I think that things have come for me to share about my

past as it will motivate others," said Arjun. After losing his family, Arjun spent a few months on the road, depending on others for survival. "During that time, I could just remember my name and parents' name. In that situation, I got in touch with a shelter home - Jeevodaya in Bhopal. They gave me a life and motivation," said Arjun, his eyes brimming moist. After seven years, he managed to meet his parents, but the happiness was short-lived. "I met them but I felt that my parents

did not care about me much. I did not want to go back to them. At that time, I vowed to myself that one day I would shine like a star in the sky," said Arjun. With help of the shelter home administrator, Arjun started playing softball. "I had represented the country in softball and also played three national meets. But, I left the game after knowing that it is not a part of the Olympics. In 2013, I went for the MP shooting academy talent hunt, but I was rejected," said Arjun.

Arjun prepared for the selection trials again and got selected in 2016. "My life completely changed from there. Frictionless coaches, awesome infrastructure and unlimited opportunities gave me a direction in life," said Arjun. Talking about his selection for the world championship, Arjun said, "I am thankful to my coaches Manoj Singh, Indrajit and Hemraj for showing confidence in me. It is because of director S.L. Thakore and sports department that I could manage to reach this level. My best target is to put my best foot forward wherever I represent the country". He added that he wants to give recognition to his parents by winning medals. "I want them to feel that I am their good son. They are very poor and I wish to make their life comfortable," said Arjun. He has been living in the shooting academy's accommodation since 2016.

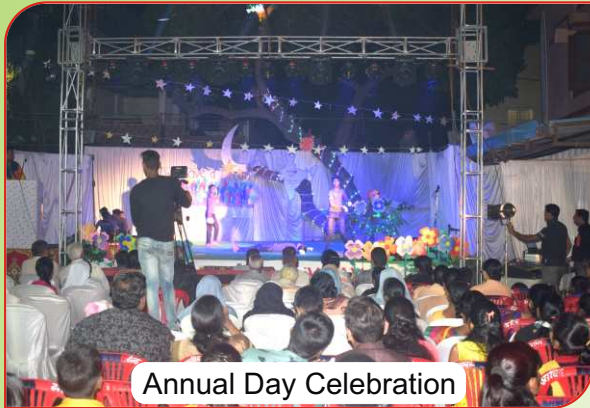
