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About Jeevodaya

Jeevodaya is a non-profit organization started in the year 1999 with the passion of helping children who are living alone in and around railway stations, runaway and missing children by providing food, shelter and education. To make Itarsi a child friendly station in 1999 Sr. Clara, Sisters of St. Joseph of Chambéry started Jeevodaya Society. Over the past 22 years Jeevodaya offered support to more than twelve thousand children, a secure and dignified life by reuniting them to their own families, rehabilitation, vocational training and job placement.

In the course of the journey, Jeevodaya learned that, if these children are not helped on time, they beg, do child labour, get involved in anti-social activities and trafficked for flesh trade. Moreover, they would lose the opportunity of enjoying childhood and be denied of developmental

opportunities. Thus, Jeevodaya decided to work in ITARSI and started a temporary shelter home for children in need of care and protection, in collaboration with West central Railway Women's Welfare Organization Also. established long term shelters for girls and boys with the support of donors and congregations. Jeevodaya ensures these children are provided education, vocational training, care and affection up to 18 years and support the above 18 years through vocational training and higher education.

In 2021 Jeevodaya celebrates its completion of 22 years of journey from the railway platforms of Itarsi railway station to providing quality residential facilities to rescued children through Child Care institutions and various other related programmes for the holistic rehabilitation of the children.

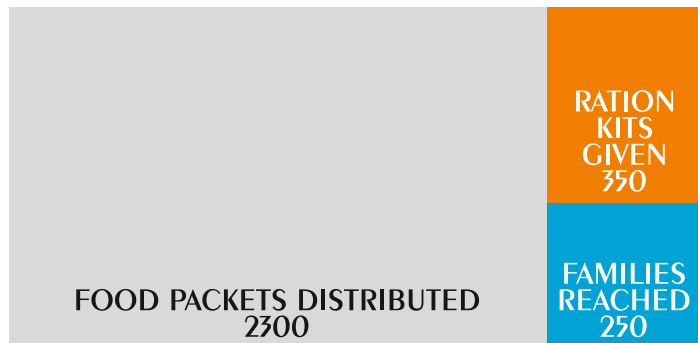

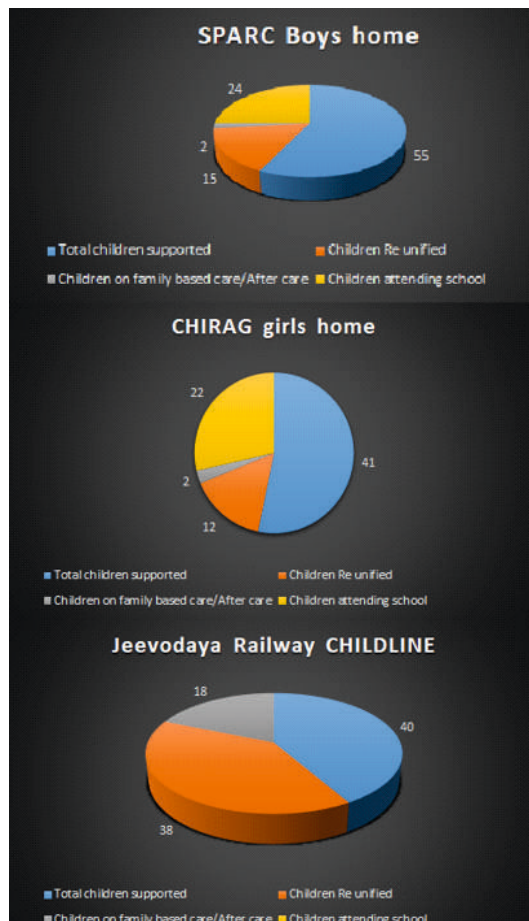



Accomplishments

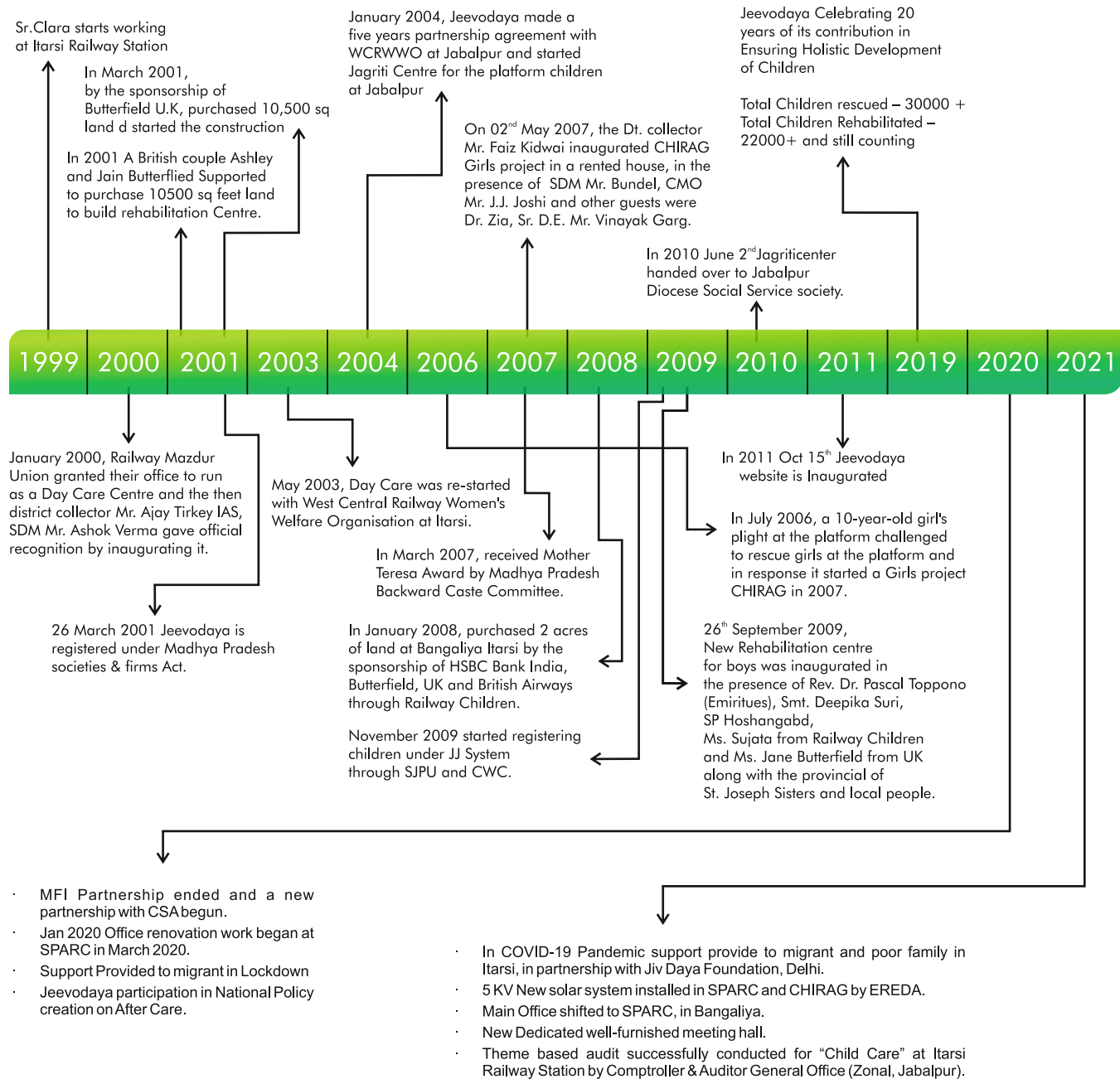
- **Children reached out through Outreach Service:** In the year 2020-21, 550 children --- - from Itarsi Railway Junction of West Centre Railway Zone of Indian Railway. Among those 235 children had been reunified with their families. Follow ups for the rehabilitated children are carried out by Jeevodaya Childline team members on regular intervals to ensure the wellbeing of these children.
- **Publication and release of Jeevodaya Annual Report:** 2019-20 It was on the occasion of Jeevodaya Annual Day Celebration, release of Jeevodaya annual report -2018-19 by Honourable Shri. Girish Sharma IAS (Principal Advisor -AIVGPA) on 16th October,2019 in the presence of guests, well-wishers and staff of Jeevodaya.
- **CHILDLINE se Dosti Campaign:** Jeevodaya Railway CHILDLINE celebrated CHILDLINE Se Dosti Campaign on the day of universal Child rights day on 14th November,2020 at Itarsi Railway station and in Chirag. The children from Jeevodaya children home together staff were part of the campaign. The team provided awareness on child rights to Government Stakeholder such as Railway Station superintend, Deputy Station superintend, Inspector- RPF, Inspector- GRP, Army officials, Itarsi local police station and non govt. Stakeholders like coolie, vendors, shop keepers, youth and railway passengers from Itarsi railway station were part of the campaign. It was one of the major sensitisation programmes held with support of children, staff and stakeholders.
- **New Partnership with CSA:** Jeevodaya has ended partnership with Miracle Foundation India by December 2019 and in place of MFI, we have collaborated with Cartelists for Social Action (CSA) for ensuring the children's wellbeing and support. The CSA will be working closely with Jeevodaya for children's education, health, mental health, computer education etc. in a professional and systematic manner.
- **Office renovation In Sparc and shifting of main office :** We started office renovation in Sparc Boys home in January 2020, since the major part of main office is shifting to Sparc renovated place. As per the plan, the offices of Accounts & Program manager will be shifting to Sparc and the office of Sparc children home office and other home activity premises are fully shift to the first floor. We shifted the office to SPARC in February 2021 .
- **CHILD Help Group Meetings:** As per the Railway SOP, CHILD Help Group was formed in the Itarsi Railway Junction under the aegis of Station Superintendent. Inspector RPF, SSO, GRP, CTI and Jeevodaya is a part of the group. In the period of April 2019 to March 2020 there are 03 CHG meetings were organised, in this meetings Jeevodaya has put many advocacy issues for the discussions.
- Jeevodaya has prepared a detailed sustainability plan for effective sustainability with Mumbai based experts. The plan includes year wise actionable and roles of each department of the organization to attain and to develop to be self-sustainable by 2025.
- New Partnership with CSA (Catalyst for Social Action) We have started new partnership with CSA – a Mumbai based donor agency for childrens health, education and after care supports. CSA has more than 10 years of experience in working with organizations and childrens. The CSA will be working closely with Jeevodaya for children's education, health, mental health, computer education etc. in a professional and systematic manner.

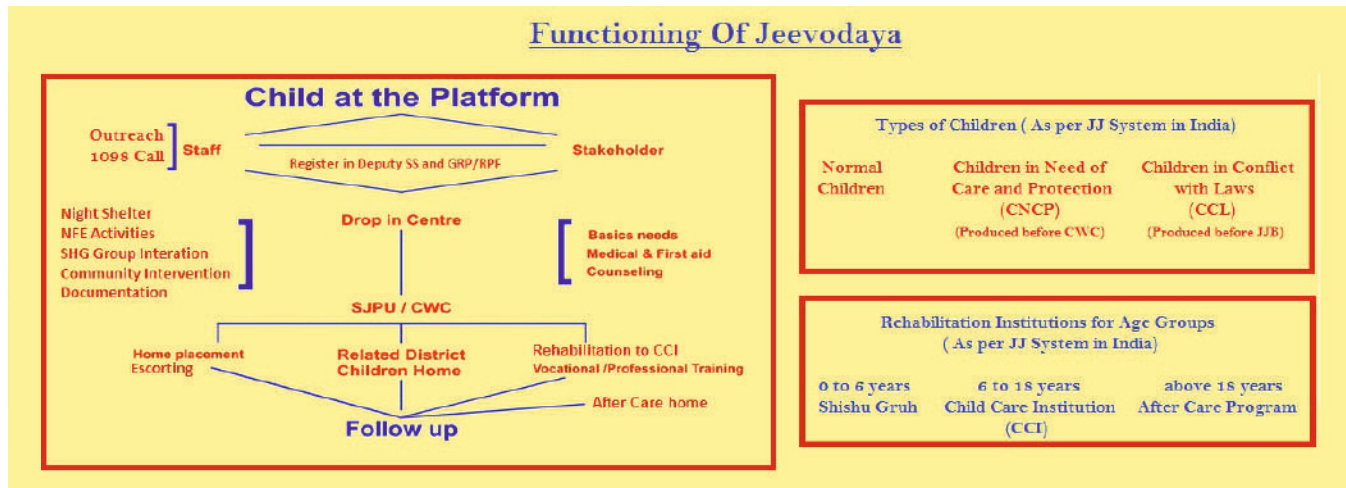
- Completion of office renovation and office shifting to SPARC. We shifted the office to SPARC boys' home in August 2020. As per the plan, the offices of Accounts & Programme manager are shifted to Sparc and the office of Sparc children home office and other home activity premises are entirely shifted to the first floor.
- Participation on Draft preparation of Model CCI of AIGGPA Govt MP Jeevodaya has been invited and participated in the draft and recommendation preparations for model child care homes with Department of good governance government of Madhya Pradesh and with Institute of Social Science New Delhi. In the study, Jeevodaya submitted the current challenges and recommendations for the government for quality care in child care institutions in Madhya Pradesh.
- Monitoring visits by Govt. officials to Jeevodaya: Govt. systems assuming ownership for the protection of children as per the directions from Supreme court of India and government ministries in central and state government. As a result, Government officials visit/monitoring are regular in Jeevodaya homes esp. ICPS officials, CWC, District judges, tribal welfare officer, District and state level Women & child department officials.
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- Child rights and Child Protection Trainings in Schools: Jeevodaya has Sensitized more than 450 children on the Safety & Protection through Good touch and Bad touch Sessions in various schools in Itarsi. Also, we provide psychological and counselling support to children who are in need and are identified through these sessions.
- 21st Annual day celebration of Jeevodaya was on 29th November, 2020. Jeevodaya celebrated its 21st Annual day with Children, older children/youth, Government stakeholders, guests, well-wishers and staff. Due to pandemic Covid 19 the celebrations were restricted, following all standing directions of the government. The chief guest was Shri Girish Sharma IAS (Director AIGGPA, Govt of MP) and the guest of honour was Shri Hemeswari Patel (CMO, Itarsi). On the occasion the annual report of 2020-21 was also released by the hands of Chief guest and Guests.

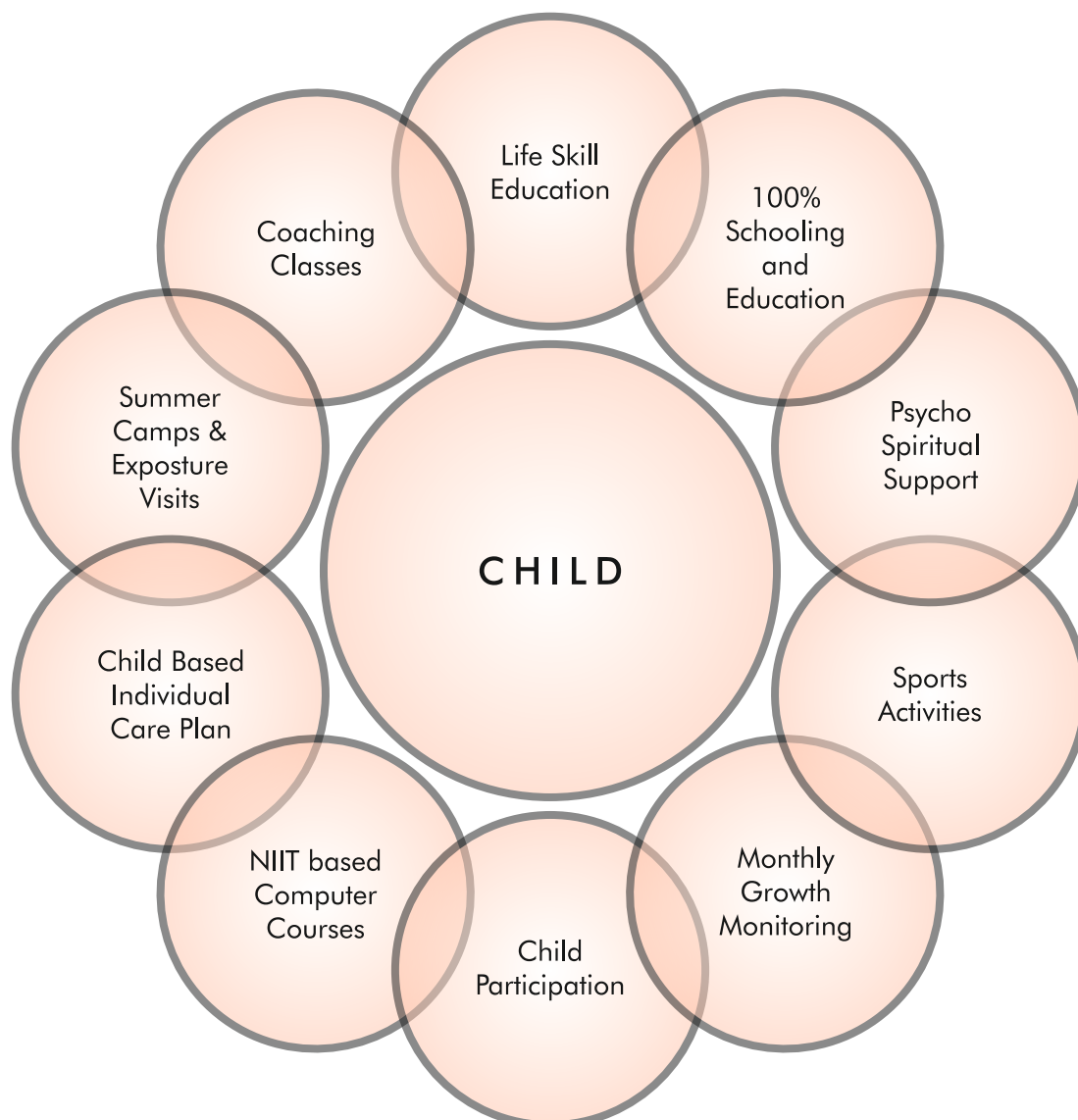

Case Study-01

After talking to a girl sitting on the railway platform, according to the girl's statement, the girl was going to her aunt's house in Delhi because the girl's aunt works in the company & they have communication on the call, so the girl is ready to work in company, so the girl was going to Delhi without informing at home, the girl told that I do not want to stay with the family at home because I have to do work. Team member interact the child on the platform no. 1, near the watering RO, Team rescued the girl child during the outreach, after

gathering information about the girl, child was produce before the Child Welfare Committee, Hoshangabad as entry also done in Deputy SS Office and GRP Police Station Itarsi and the girl's family was contacted on the call. Girl was counseled and shelter given in to girl's CCI. As per the recommendation of Child Welfare Committee as family came to hoshangabad, Girl was handed over to mother. Presently child is with the family.

Case Study-02

One child is found at Itarsi Railway Station. According to the child's statement, he came from Mandideep to Itarsi with an uncle as he wants to go to his maternal grandfather's house. That uncle left him at itarsi railway station. The child was sitting alone in the musafir khana. The child was contacted by a stakeholder and stakeholder contact to Child Help Desk, then child was

rescued by team member, the information of the child was given in the Deputy SS office and GRP police station and after counselling of child as he told the address, family was contacted on the call. Same day family came to Itarsi and The child was handed over safely to the family. Presently child is with the family.

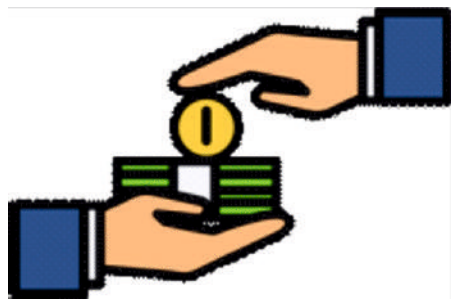

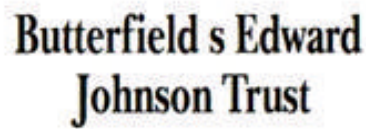
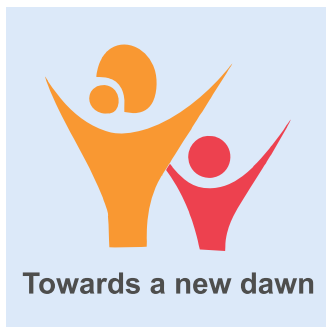
